

# HOW TO UPLOAD A VIDEO TO YOUTUBE

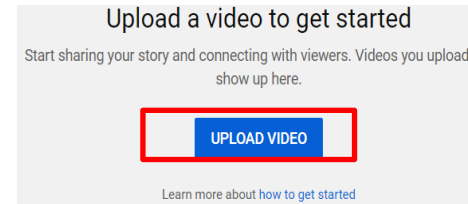
## Access YouTube

1. Go to [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com).
2. Click **Sign in**. You can sign in with your Saint Francis University email account.



## Upload a Video to YouTube

3. Click the **Create a video** icon at the top of the page and select **Upload Video**.



\*Note: The first time you access YouTube with your account, you may be asked to set up your channel and give some information. You may also be asked to create a name for your channel and add links, which you can do later if you'd like.

4. Click **select file** and begin uploading.
5. As the video is uploading, you can edit things such as the title, description, and tags. You also must select what audience can view it.

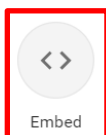

6. Click **Next** and go to **Visibility**.
7. Under Publish Now, select **Unlisted** and then **Done**.
  - a. Public = anybody can view it
  - b. Unlisted = anyone who has the link can view it
  - c. Private = only seen by the usernames you select
8. Select the **Embed** option and copy the embed code. You can then use this code in Canvas.
